What is Positive Media's Mission Statement?

The mission of Positive Media is to support and leverage positive media that entertains, engages, and inspires audiences worldwide.

Is experience necessary?

Experience in the fields relating to business, marketing, non-profits, film production and distribution are certainly an asset but not required.

Is the internship a paid or volunteer position?

The internship is a full or part-time volunteer opportunity.

The full-time program is a comprehensive program which offers activities beyond the normal work hours.

How old are the interns?

Interns generally range in age from college, post-college, and young professionals.

Will flexibility with dates be a problem?

Specific dates are established for each semester long internship. If an intern has a concern or conflict with these dates it will be handled on an individual basis.

What are we looking for?

People who want to volunteer and dedicate their time and talents to help carry out the mission of Positive Media: to promote movies that matter and have the potential to make a meaningful difference in people's lives.

What kind of people will I be working with?

We intentionally seek to comprise the internship with individuals who seek to serve the mission of supporting positive media in culture.

As a potential intern, what are the living accommodations like? Will I reside with other interns?

Yes you will most likely reside with other interns. Accommodations are within walking distance of the office and most everything you will need during your time in the internship.

Does the internship provide transportation?

The internship does not provide transportation. Work is close to the accommodations, within a few blocks – within walking or biking distance. Our location is unique in that all is all that you should need while in the internship is within walking distance – churches, grocery store, beach, shops, restaurants, etc.

Is it necessary that I bring a car?

A car is not a necessity while participating in the internship, as similarly described above, everything you should need while here – shops, restaurants, churches, beaches, a grocery store, etc – is within walking distance of accommodations. There is also public transportation if you wish to use it.

If you wish to bring a vehicle to the internship you will be responsible for coordinating logistics and costs of having the vehicle – parking, gas, etc.

What is the expected cost while participating in the internship?

The internship does not have a program fee, only an initial administrative processing fee. Your cost will simply be your anticipated living costs.

What should I bring?

Bring business casual clothes for work, sports clothes, and casual clothes for off hours. Jeans may be worn in the office if dressy.

West Palm Beach/ Southern Florida is a tropical climate and can be quite warm, but all interns are expected to abide by the standards of modesty in their dress. Summers can be particularly humid. A coat in case of travel is a good idea as well as a formal outfit for events that may come up.

Do I need to bring my laptop with me?

Yes, a computer is required - Please specify if you cannot bring one.

Is it a safe environment?

Our office and apartments are located on a beautiful, very family friendly area of West Palm Beach.

What is the area like?

The office is in a great area – just a few blocks away from the beach, shops, churches, etc.

The weather is generally very warm, but you may need a jacket at night during the winter months.

What are the characteristics you are looking for in an intern?

Honesty, dedication, the ability to live and work well with others, and a spirit of seeing the work we do with a spirit of service.

What skills are considered most useful for success in the position?

Personal and professional organization, computer proficiency and a strong prayer life are some of the many skills that will be advantageous to this position.

Is there telemarketing involved?

Yes, there is some telemarketing involved.

Will I be working out of an office or remotely?

Both in the office and remotely.
